



Guided Tours at Bloedel Reserve

OVERVIEW

Guided tours through the Reserve are available for groups of 6 to 24 attendees, and are lead by Bloedel Reserve staff members.

COST

Regular admission prices, plus \$150 per tour guide. One tour guide is required per 12 attendees.

Note: Groups of 24 attendees must pay for two tour guides at \$150 each.

TOUR LENGTH & AVAILABILITY

Each tour is approximately 1.5 hours, and can be scheduled Tuesdays - Fridays, year round.

ACCESSIBILITY

Tours are on foot. Contact Kate Sunderland if there are people in the group with limited mobility to discuss possible routes and options.

TYPES OF TOURS CURRENTLY OFFERED

Tours are customized depending on the group's interests and mobility. Areas of focus typically include the Japanese Garden, Moss Garden, Reflection Pool, Residence landscape, and Rhododendron Glen.

General Tours Include a history of the gardens, buildings (Japanese Guest House and Residence), the Bloedel family, and seasonal plant interest.

Horticulture Tours include history, character-defining features highlighting different garden areas, plant identification, and seasonal interest.
